2. Bundle of green oats, to be judged for grain yield.
3. Bundle of green malt barley (2 row), to be judged for grain yield.
4. Bundle of green feed barley (2 row), to be judged for grain yield.
5. Bundle of green peas, to be judged for grain yield.
6. Bundle of green beans, to be judged for grain yield.
7. Bundle of green chick peas, to be judged for grain yield.
8. Bundle of green vetch, to be judged for grain yield.
9. Bundle of lentils, for grain yield.
10. Bundle of vetch, for fodder production.
11. Bundle of clover, for fodder production.
12. Bundle of canola for grain yield.
13. Bundle of lupins for grain yield.
14. Bundle triticale for grain yield
