Classes 1 to 8 will be weighed and judged on commercial value, and counts of quality and market value will be placed on all fleeces.

Prize money: 1st \$5, 2nd \$3, unless stated otherwise.

Prize money will be available from Convenor on Show Day.

Classes 1 to 4, one skirted fleece with belly and pieces shown.

1. Fine and medium wool Merino ram
2. Strong wool Merino ram
3. Fine and medium wool Merino ewe
4. Strong wool Merino ewe
5. Set of three skirted fleeces from either Merino ewe or wether (unhoused) to be judged on commercial value. First \$25, Second \$15, Third \$10. Prizemoney donated by Callum Downs Commodity News.
6. Skirted fleece from commercial ewe (unhoused)
7. Skirted fleece from commercial wether (unhoused)
8. Skirted fleece from commercial hogget under 15 months (unhoused)
9. Best Commercial Dohne Wool
10. Best commercial fleece, skirted, Merino ewe or wether (paddock reared). Fleeces in this class remain property of Clare A.&H. Society for shearing upgrade.
